As such we serve over 8,000 people a year, have five full time staff and over 100 contract facilitators. Our facilities include: a 52-element challenge course, a climbing chimney, an orienteering course, a seminar building, yurts and access to over 100 acres on the Great Bay.

Youth and Student Programs facilitator's responsibilities include: delivery of portable games and initiative programs and low and high challenge course programs.

This position is on-call, per diem and typically runs April-October. We are looking for individuals who have a strong facilitation background and comfort and talent in working with diverse groups of school aged populations.

Required skills include:

- facilitating challenge courses
- leading cooperative games
- facilitating problem solving initiatives
- knowledgeable of adventure models

Applicants must have current First Aid and CPR certification and be able to attend our technical competency check-off.

Starting pay rate: \$120-\$140/day, with the ability to increase rate to \$180/day for additional responsibilities and experience with the Browne Center.
